# Basic information

- All children have the right to thirteen years of free education

- Starting students are called freshmen, then they become sophomores, next juniors and finally seniors
- The SAT (Scholastic Aptitude Test) is an equivalent of our Maturita exam



# Universities and colleges

- High school graduates can go to college or university
- Tertiary education is very expensive, compare:
- one-year cost at public university (tuition, books, room and board) \$ 28.000
- one-year cost at private university \$ 40.000
- Some students get a scholarship

# Ivy League

- Is an athletic conference composed of sports teams from eight private institutions of higher education in the Northeastern USA
- Generally speaking, Ivy league is a synonym for the most prestigious American universities
- It includes: Harvard University, Yale University, Princeton University


Ivy was planted at a
