- 84 % of the population of the UK

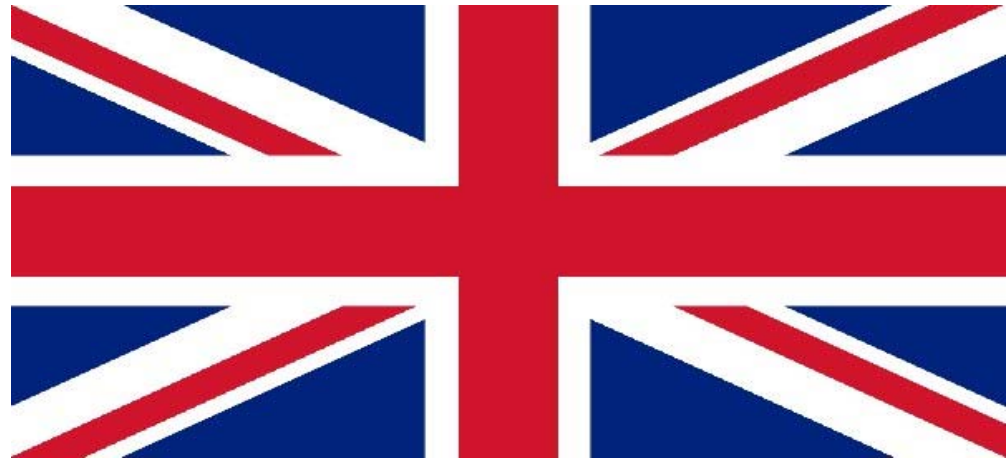
History:
