Stages of education

- ◆ **Pre-school education:** - nursery school
- kindergarten
- ◆ **Primary education 5 – 11:** - infant school (5-7)
- junior school (8-11)
- ◆ **Secondary education 11 – 16 – 18:** - grammar school (7%)
- comprehensive school
- public school (7%)
- ◆ **Tertiary education:** - university
- college

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Public schools

- ◆ **The most expensive private schools**
- ◆ **Fee - paying pupils**
- ◆ **Single – sex schools**
- ◆ **School uniforms**
- ◆ **Strict/rigid discipline**
- ◆ **Great emphasis on team sports**
- ◆ **Eton, Harrow, Rugby, Winchester**



The National Curriculum

- Introduced in 1988 (for the first time in British history)
- Subjects you have to study
- Assessment tests you have to take
- Between the ages 14-16 you study for GCSE
- At the age of 16: a/ leaving school
b/ preparation for A levels
- At the age of 18 you take : a/ A levels
b/ A- Supplementary
c/ GNVQ

Universities and colleges

- ◆ Are not part of the state system of education
 - ◆ Are independent, often supported by public funds
 - ◆ 91 universities (offer 3 + 4 year degree courses)
 - ◆ 47 colleges of higher education (offer 2year + degree courses)

- ◆ Degrees: Bachelor´s
 Master´s
 Doctorate

Types of universities

- **Stone universities: Oxford, Cambridge („Oxbridge“)**
- **Red-brick universities: 19th century, London**
- **20th century: many newly-born, Birmingham, Manchester, Glasgow**
- **Open universities: distance education, internet, tutorial system, started 1969**

Oxford and Cambridge

- The oldest universities (medieval period, 12th, 13th century)
- The highest academic reputation
- Colleges built around courtyards (quads) with lawns in the centre
