Winston Churchill



Sir Winston Churchill

(1874-1965)

- a British politician
- known chiefly for his leadership of the United Kingdom during World War II
- served as Prime Minister of the United Kingdom from 1940 to 1945 and again from 1951 to 1955
- refused to surrender to the Nazis

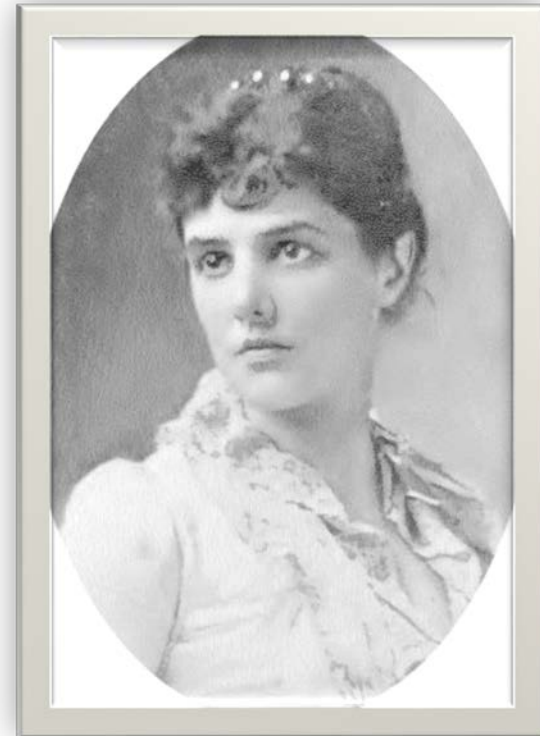

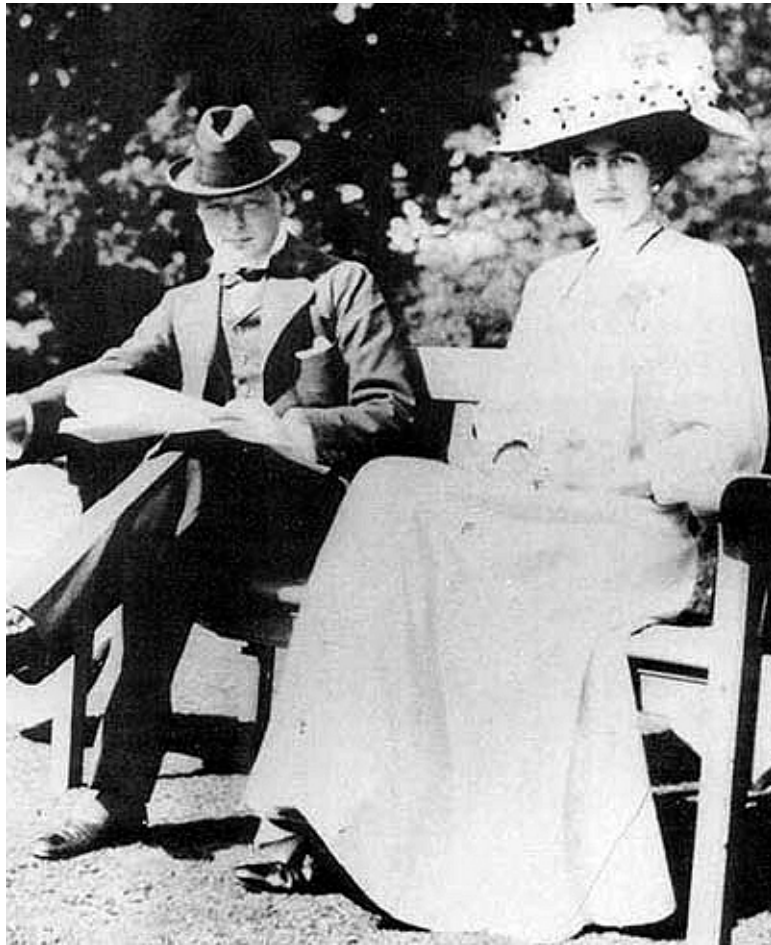

- **“We make a living by what we get, but we make a life by what we give.”**
- **“If you are going to go through hell, keep going.”**
- **“The problems of victory are more agreeable than those of defeat, but they are no less difficult.”**
- **Nancy Astor: “Sir, if you were my husband, I would give you poison.”**
Churchill: “If I were your husband I would take it.”
- **“I would say to the House, as I said to those who have joined this government: I have nothing to offer but blood, toil, tears and sweat.”**
