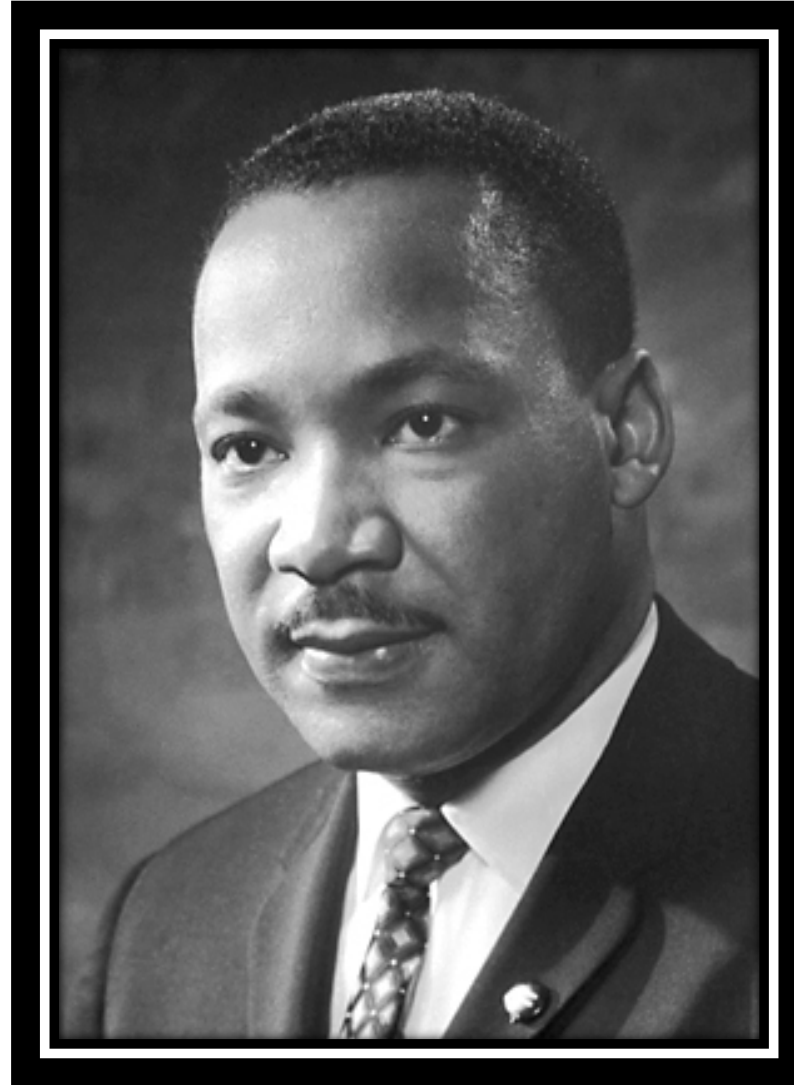

Martin Luther King

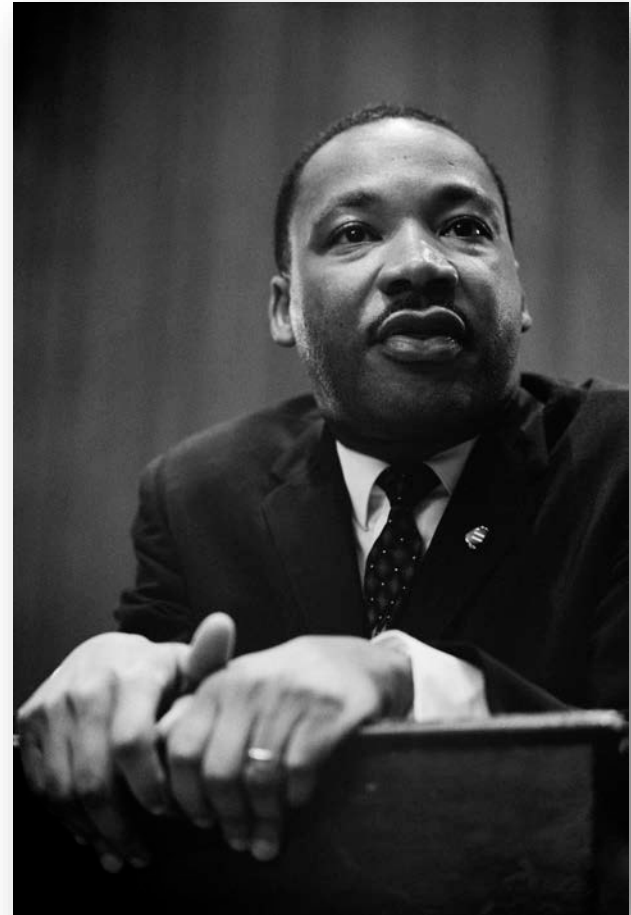
(1929-68)

- the most important leader of the US civil rights movement
- an African-American Baptist minister
- in 1963 led about 25000 people on a protest march to Washington DC
- made there his famous “I have a dream” speech at the Lincoln Memorial
- awarded the Nobel Peace Prize in 1964

- inspired by Mahatma Gandhi's success with non-violent activism
- murdered in 1968 in Memphis, Tennessee by Earl Ray

“I have a dream”

- a public speech by American activist Martin Luther King, Jr.
- delivered by King on August 28, 1963, in which he called for an end to racism in the United States
- *“I have a dream that my four little children will one day live in a nation where they will not be judged by the color of their skin but by the content of their character.”*
