Aborigines nowadays

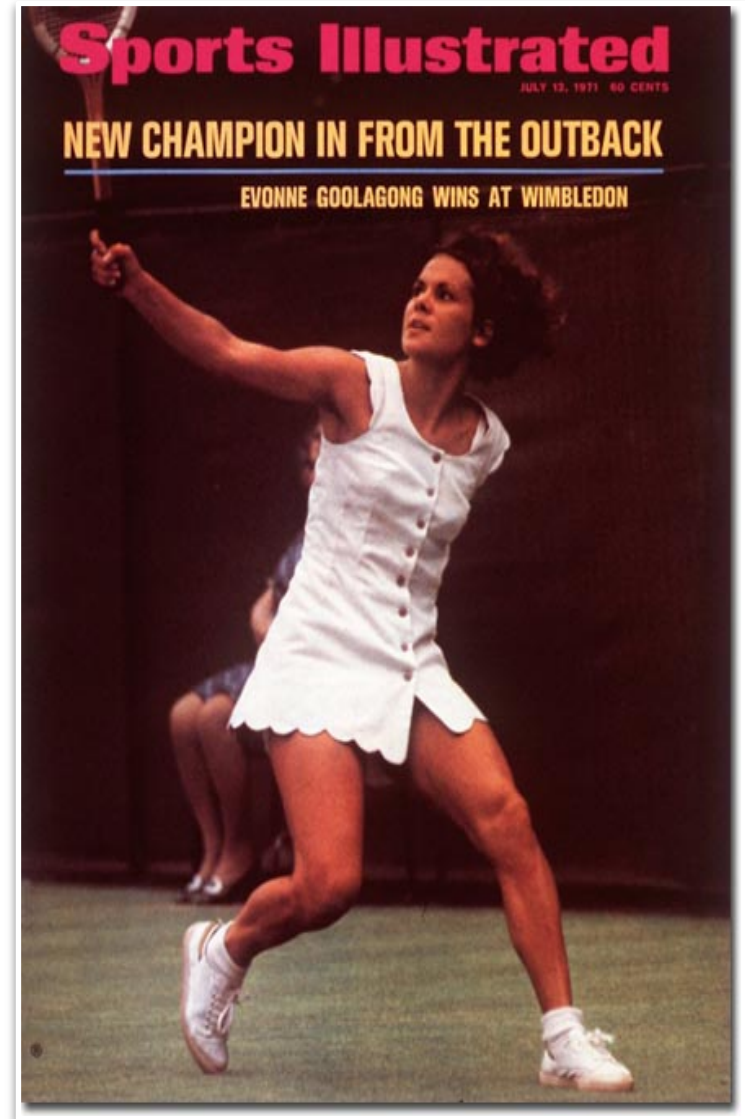
- ❖ the end of traditional lifestyle
