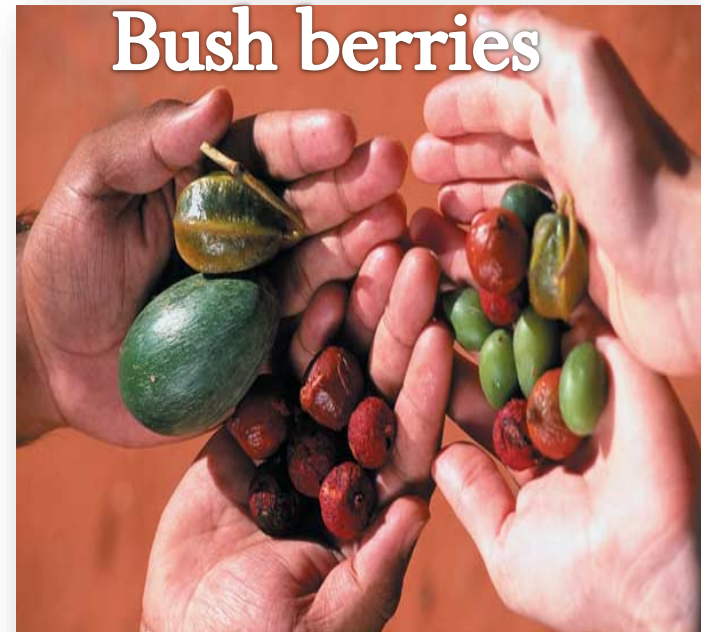


Witchetty grubs
