- ❖ playing and watching sports
- ❖ barbecues
- ❖ fireworks

ANZAC DAY

- ❖ celebrated on 25th April
- ❖ remembers Australian soldiers died in World Wars
- ❖ the morning mass at war memorials
- ❖ war veterans march in parades
