N.W.T.

- is one of three federal territories of Canada
- the current borders were formed April 1, 1999, with the creation of Nunavut.
- it had a population of 41,462 (2011)
- in 1967, as a result of recommendations by the Carrothers Commission, Yellowknife became the capital
- it is surrounded by many bodies of water
- it is known for its mineral production
