

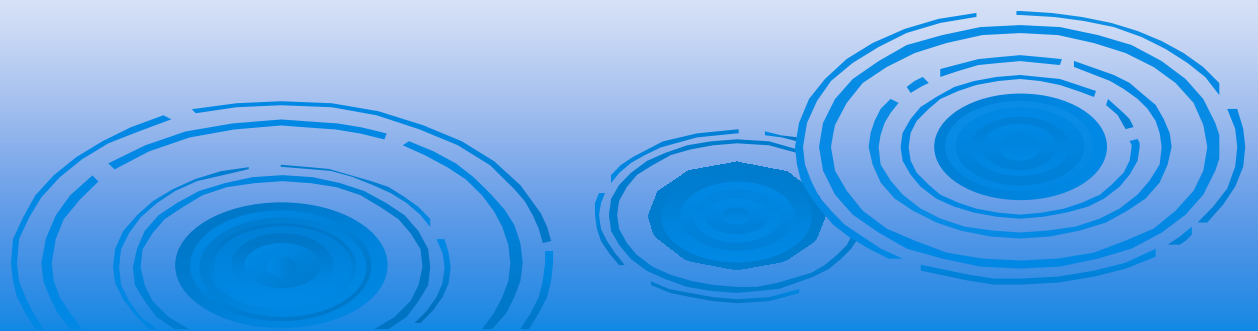

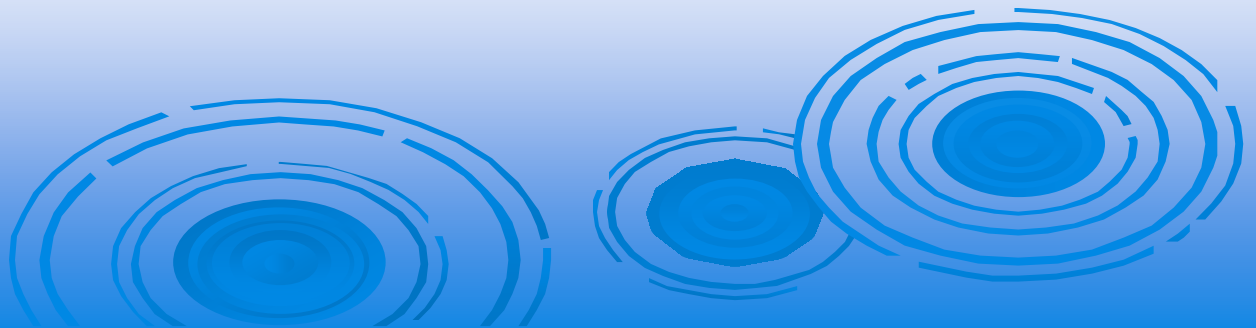
CANADA

- is a member of the **British Commonwealth of Nations**
- is a constitutional monarchy, a federal state and parliamentary democracy
- the monarch of the United Kingdom, currently Queen Elizabeth II., is in fact the ceremonial head of state – she holds little power
- her representative is the Governor General



CANADA

- the Cabinet : Prime Minister
- **the Canadian Parliament** is composed of
 - Queen / Governor General
 - The House of Commons
 - The Senate
- The National Parliament is located in the capital Ottawa



Government

- in Canada, there are 3 levels of government. Each level of government has different responsibilities:
- Federal government (the Government of Canada) - responsible for things that affect the whole country, such as citizenship and immigration, national defence and trade with other countries.



Government

- Provincial and territorial governments (for example, the Province of Ontario) - responsible for such things as education, health care and highways
- Municipal (local) governments (cities, towns, and villages in Ontario) - responsible for firefighting, city streets and other local matters.
- If there is no local government, the province provides services.
