THOMAS CHANDLER HALIBURTON



- was a politician, judge
- the author in the British Colony of Nova Scotia
- he was the first international best-selling author



CHARLES HEAVYSEGE (1816-1876)



- an excellent poet
- was from Ontario



CHARLES SANGSTER (1822-1893)



- created Canadian poetry in 19th century
- is considered to be Canada's national poet



STEPHEN LEACOCK (1869-1944)



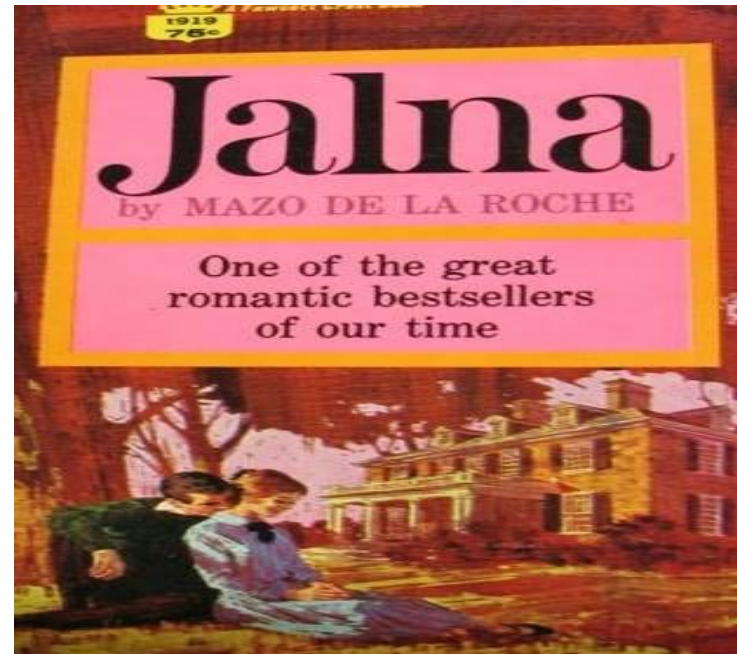
- the best known author translated into Czech
- with his *Literary Lapses, How to Write* and his autobiography *The Boy I Left Behind Me*



MAZO DE LA ROCHE (1885-1961)



- developed realism in fiction
- Creator of Jalna series



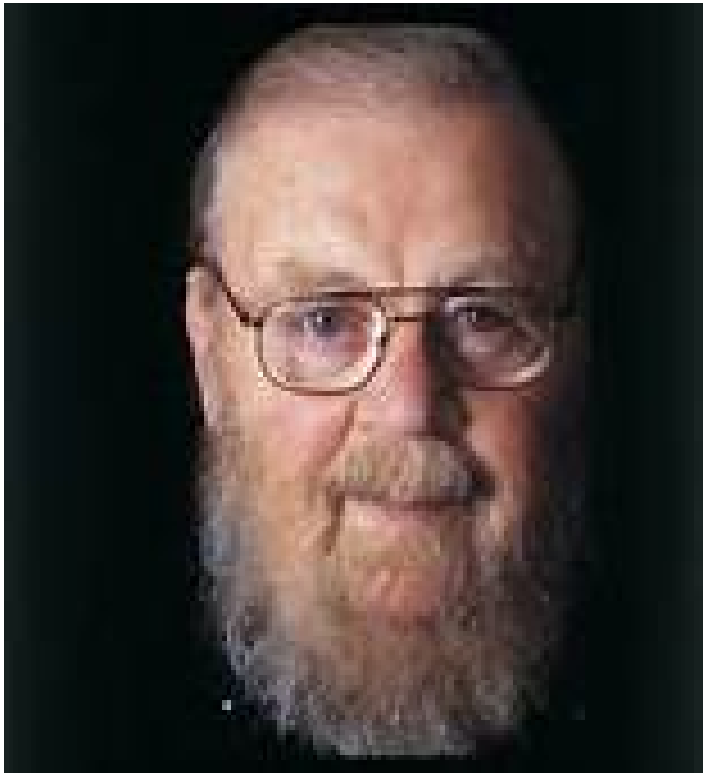
L.M.MONTGOMERY



- widely read outside Canada
- *Anne of Green Gables* (1908) became a children's classic



FARLEY MOWAT (1921 -)



- contemporary Canadian author
- translated into Czech too
- *The Desperate People, Never Cry Wolf* etc.
